On 25th of July 2019, individuals from different part of the Philippines, and even from other countries came to enlist themselves for PAFCOE Batch 15 training. The long wait is over, now Batch 15 shall arise.

There are 32 full-course students and five from the iPreach Sunday training. Overall, there are thirty-seven students who will undergo PAFCOE's intensive training. As per data, most of them are professional individuals who chose to stop from their regular employment to commit their lives in the Lord's work. Some even have paused from their schooling to attend PAFCOE.

After 3 years of having less than 20 trainees per training session, we are in awe and praising the Lord for the 37 aspiring evangelists He has entrusted to be trained by PAFCOE. Batch 15 is indeed a miracle!

Since its inception, PAFCOE has always been a faith based ministry. We are dependent upon the grace of God and the generosity of his people. This ministry has been financially sustained by the donations of wonderful people that God has touched in marvelous ways. This time, we need even more help.

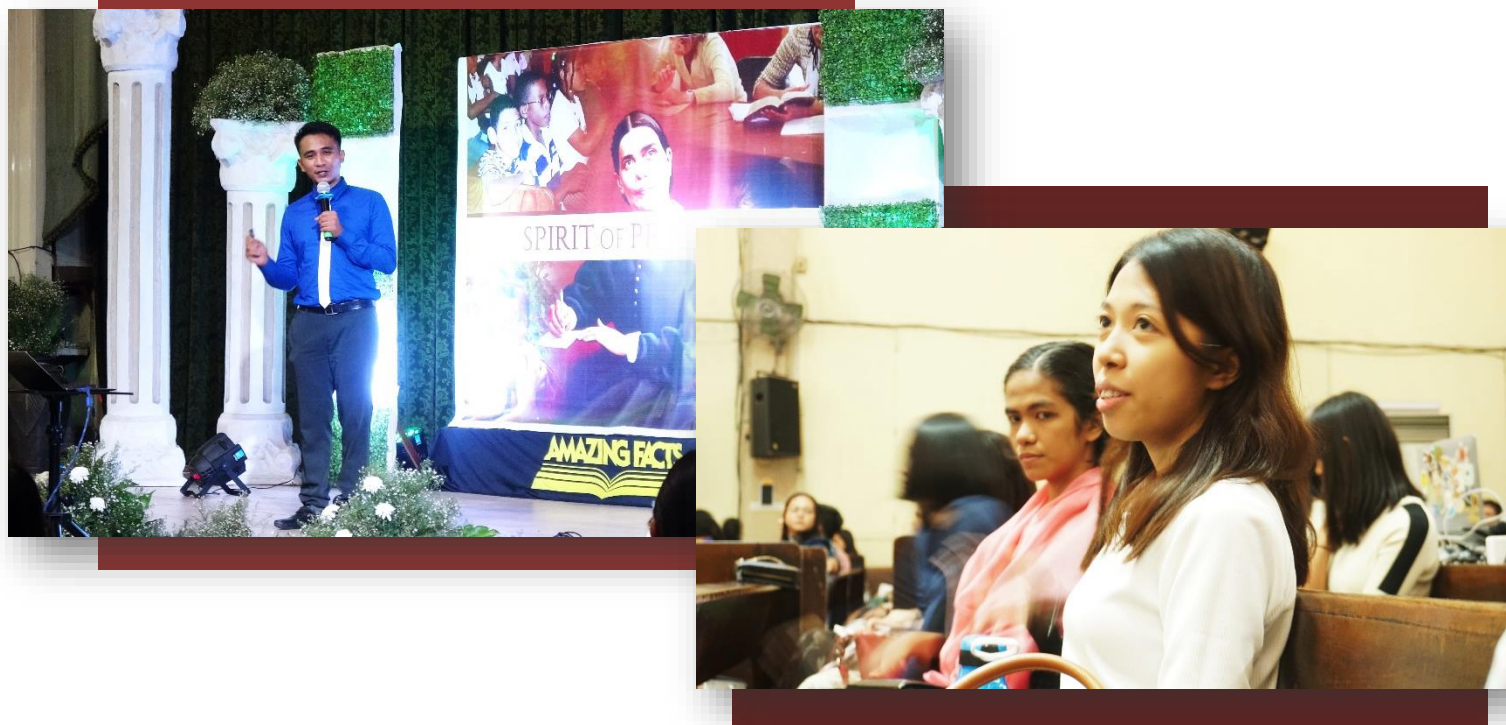
16 of our Full-course trainees took a leap of faith and applied for our scholarship program. People who apply for scholarship are required to submit a proof of commendable performance such as a certificate of recognition, grade slip, service record, etc.. This gives us an initial guarantee that the applicant will excel during the training. When approved, a scholarship applicant will sign a contract that would require him to serve as a full-time missionary with PAFCOE for at least 6 months.

We know very well that our available Scholarship Fund cannot cover all the applicants. In fact, what we have right now can only accommodate 3 full-course trainees. Most of the scholarship applicants quit their job just to be able to join the training. Some have already been serving as missionaries but realized the advantages they will acquire from PAFCOE. We were inspired by their dedication. So, in spite of our lack of funds, we decided to walk by faith and approved 14 scholars. We don't have the money yet but we believe with all our hearts that God is faithful!

Each Scholar needs 27,000.00 pesos (540.00 US dollars) to cover their tuition expenses. **We are earnestly praying for a total of 297,000.00 pesos (5,940.00 US dollar) to materialize all 11 full-course scholarship grants.**
