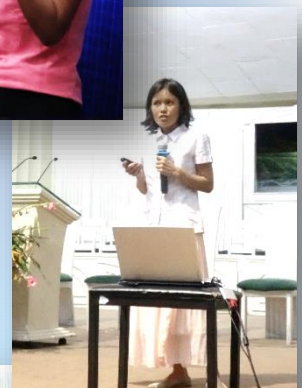
Preaching Practice is conducted to evaluate how students are able to apply what they learned from evangelistic preaching and vocal culture classes—vocal support, vocal tone, eye contact, presentation, slide coordination, style, mannerisms, and others. The students were oriented that the Preaching Practice would prepare them for their OJT and that only those who will have a passing grade will be recommended to go.

Several days before the day of Preaching Practice, the students were given sermons scripts for them to study. On the day of preaching practice, the coaches first gave advices and demonstrations to the students. After which, the students were evaluated.

Regarding the students' experiences, Rommel commented, "My experience was so amazing. I learned that I have distracting gestures to remove, for me to become a good preacher. Q: When to Trust Again When We are Betrayed?

It is not our nature to give our full trust again whenever it is being breached by someone else. It is in our innate being to punish those who do us wrong. The desire to give them a second chance, and to show trust in them again, is usually foreign to us. We have to recognize that the Spirit of God is the only One who can work inside a person to have compassionate actions. Only God's marvelous love enables us to trust those who have disappointed us and may have disappointed us again. But the ultimate question here is: when do we trust again when we are betrayed? Let us read what the Word of God has to say in this kind of situation.



The Bible commands in 1 Peter 2:17— Honour all men. Love the brotherhood..." In order to honor and love all men, this requires trust. There is nothing that honors someone more than our absolute trust in them. 1 Corinthians 13:4 tells us that "Charity (Love) suffereth long, and is kind; charity envieth not; charity vaunteth not itself, is not puffed up". Love always trusts & always places the most favorable interpretation on others' motives & acts even to the most notorious person in the world. We must look for good in others and expect it from them. Treating them that they have worth. Oh how typical it is to look only for the worst! Honour all men as the Word says. If only we could see people through the Father's eyes, then we could look upon them with infinite love & compassion as our true brothers and sisters— even in the face of disappointment & betrayal.

Remember the reaction of the older brother in the

parable of the prodigal son? When the father, overjoyed at the return of his wandering son, he called a feast to celebrate but the older son would have nothing to do with it. The Bible even says, "He was angry, & would not go in". (Luke 15:28). His actions clearly stated that if he had been with the father's shoes, he would not welcome the prodigal son's return. Being suspicious to his brother based on his deeds in the past, he pointed out how fool the father would be if he would let himself get conned again by taking back a son who can never be trusted. But, the father does trusts the prodigal son. In spite of the dreadful mistakes the young man has done to the father, nothing is more valuable than his own boy—the one who was lost but is now found. He gives him the finest robe and an expensive ring. Far from being ashamed of his son, he wants to honor this boy who is worth everything to him.

We may claim to be God's children and if our claims are true, then our own brother who was lost and dead must be considered alive and found because he is bound by the closest ties to God. Our Father in heaven recognizes him as His son. If we deny our relationship to our fellow brothers & sisters, we show that we are but hirelings in the household and not children in the family of God. In an almost humorous way, God once revealed the sham of our unforgiving, untrusting human natures when He said: "I will not execute the fierceness of mine anger, I will not return to destroy Ephraim: for I am God, and not man" (Hosea 11:9).

Jesus Christ was the most trusting Person there ever was. He was taken advantage of more than anyone else. Yet, this did not stop Him from trusting. His life clearly shows us that it is far better to trust people and be betrayed than to cheat ourselves of real depth in our human relation by not trusting at all. He trusted Simon, the irritating, impetuous, & boasting fisherman. He trusted Zacchaeus, the shrewd, conniving, deceitful little tax collector. Mary, too, who was caught in the act of adultery (not mention she was a prostitute). Jesus Christ risked His trust. His trust extended even to Judas although He knew very well that Judas would just betray Him. *continued on next page >>>*

Vegan Recipe:

Baked "Cheesy" Mashed Potato

Who said that being vegan is saying farewell to your favorite cheese flavor?

Cheese lovers, it is just saying farewell to the cheese itself, but not on the taste. So, say good bye to guilt, and hello to health! The recipe below is surely a food you will love most.

Serving suggestion: 10-12 persons

Ingredients:

- 2 kilos Potato
- 1/8 kilo cashew nuts
- 2 cloves garlic
- 2 pcs. medium size onion
- 2 pcs. sweet red bell paper
- 8 stalks onion spring
- Dried & crushed basil leaves to drizzle on top
- Salt to taste

Procedure:

1. Pray
2. Boil the potatoes.
3. Blend all the ingredients (garlic, onion, red bell pepper, onion spring, & cashew nuts) and pour one cup of water into the blender. Put salt to taste.
4. Get the boiled potatoes and mashed it into a container.
5. Mix the blended ingredients with the mashed potatoes thoroughly.
6. Transfer and put it to container pans and press using a spatula to fit in.
7. Drizzle the dried and crushed basil leaves on top.
8. Bake it at 120 °C for approximately 30-40 minutes.
9. Lastly, take it out and slice into medium square or rectangular sizes. Garnish and serve.

Dare to be like Garlic

We often hear about garlic that has the ability to lower blood pressure and many other medicinal properties that we may get out of it, but didn't we know that only when garlics are mashed, chopped, sliced, minced, or pressed before cooking can we truly benefit from its incredible health promoting properties?



Garlic has a molecule called *Allicin*—a compound that likes to be crushed, bruised, and hashed. When garlic feels threatened or when it is damaged, the chemical reaction actually produces this

mighty *Allicin*. So, when we are hashing garlic, we are actually releasing its most potent ingredient.

Same is true with our spiritual walk, as we journey on this life. We may face a number of challenges, trials and afflictions. But, we should not by any means be discouraged nor be dismayed, for the Bible says in James 1:3-4 "Knowing this, that the trying of your faith worketh patience. But let patience have her perfect work, that ye may be perfect and entire, wanting nothing," and 2 Cor. 4:17 says that "Our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory."

The Pen of Inspiration in SD 193 states that *If we have perfect love, we shall know that God is not seeking to endure us, but that in the midst of trails, and griefs, and pains, He is seeking to make us perfect, and to test the quality of our faith. When we cease to worry about*

the future, and begin to believe that God loves us, and means to do us good, we shall trust Him as a child trust a loving parent. Then our troubles and torments will disappear, and our will be swallowed up in the will of God. We may feel pressed down and walloped by pain, sorrow, and affliction, but let not these hinder us from praising the One whom we owe our everlasting life—the God who is the Author and Finisher of our faith.

In addition, MH 482 states that *In the darkest days, when appearance seems most forbidding, have faith in God. He is working out His will, doing all things in behalf of His people.* So, rather than focusing on circumstances, we ought to trust God in the deepest sense of believing that He will work in us a far more exceeding and eternal weigh of glory.

"God would not have us remain pressed down by dumb sorrow, with sore and breaking hearts. He would have us look up and behold His dear face of love. - PAFCOE is also praying for a facility that can accommodate all of its departments
- Manila Center SDA Church in partnership with PAFCOE would like to build a church structure in Brgy. Manresa, Quezon City for the newly formed Manresa SDA Company. Because of this, we are soliciting funds to buy a lot and building materials. While this is not yet available, we are soliciting funds for the company to be able to rent a decent worship place.
