#### **Stories to Tell: Overcoming Challenges**

PAFCOE life is not free from challenges. In fact, its presence is what makes the training meaningful. The students have a good share of it especially during the training seminar. Maybe you've wondered how these trainees overcame it. To answer all your queries, read on and learn how.



Since the time Rona started her PAFCOE journey, she kept on looking forward to work with children. But little did know that her heart's desire would try her patience to the utmost. "It wasn't as how I expected it though in the children's evangelism. Working with the little ones, from ages 5-11, is very challenging to a point where I was almost about to break down." Rona's children were among the noisiest and most unruly attendees. "But God was teaching me to be more patient. At the end of the program, I felt very blessed as I looked back from how they were in day 1 and how they had changed and developed (somehow) throughout the program."

Worse than Rona's experience, Marevic almost gave up in specializing child evangelism because of the children she was handling. "Seeing most of them just chit-chatting and making disturbances instead of listening to the story, I considered my effort in fetching them as useless." But during those trying times, the Lord kept on reminding her of the verse found in Matthew 19:14; and she held onto it.

"Two days before the children's program came to an end, the Lord showed me that I didn't have to dwell on the thought that my children weren't learning anything. That was Thursday and we were told to visit those who signed up for baptism. One of my children decided to be baptized. He was Mike, an 11-year-old boy. Among the children I had, he was the one I liked because of his good character. When my partner and I cleared him for baptism, we were so amazed that he understood everything. So we asked the permission of his parents and they consented. We were so happy to hear it."

Then the unexpected happened when she least expected it. "On the day of baptism, I was so happy. I went early to Mike's house to pick him up, but his parents changed their mind. They didn't allow him to be baptized. The firm decision saddened Mike and I. I just pray that those truths he came to know will still remain in his heart as he grows and will be able to stand for what he believed."

When the prophecy seminar started, Jelaville realized that her managed time needed more management. "The schedule was so hectic, and my energy was put to the utmost. We usually got home late and I was so sleepy already. But, bed was not the first place I had to be for my only pair of uniform needed to be washed. I even had a hard time finding an opportunity to do my assignments."

During those tough times, she asked God to keep her in


### Groundwork: Preparing the Work field and the Workers
