#### PROHECIES OF HOPE ADULT'S SEMINAR...







One of the major Experience all PAFCOE students can have is the Prophecies of Hope (Training) Seminar. For what honor is this from the Lord to be permitted to work with Him in lifting up the oppressed of the Great Antagonist!

The POHS started last February 26 in Brgy. San Isidro, Galas, a vastly populated area. This was a joint effort of two Churches, Manila Center and Sampaloc SDA Church. Following the example of Jesus who ministered to the whole being, It commenced with a Health Expo which lasted for four days from 5:00-6:20 pm. After enjoying the free services, the people were blessed and filled with Health Instructions from the medical doctors. The Adults and Children's Program then followed simultaneously in different halls.

Doctor Anna, one of those who actively participated in the effort shared her experience, "There were lots of people who came in the first day from all walks of life. Majority of them were elderlies that were complaining of several chronic illnesses, such as hypertension, diabetes, heart disease, previous cerebrovascular accidents with residuals, and chronic pains in the different parts of their body. Most of them were interested to avail of the services like blood chemistry, ECG and eye examination. Those complaining of pains were also glad to receive massage and hydrotherapy.

There were also children and young people who consulted me. Symptoms varied from simple cough and cold to as serious as heart failure secondary to hyperthyroidism. Majority of them complained of infectious problems, like respiratory infections and skin infections. A good proportion of them also came in due to toothache from dental carries, as well as problems with error of refractions. I made several referral letters and laboratory requests for those patients who warrant further work-up and management.

I noticed also that the booths for NEWSTART health lectures were also filled with attendees. In summary, I noticed that conducting Health Expo is a good means of bringing people in for the seminar. Just like in the time of Jesus, where sick people thronged Him for their desire to receive immediate relief from their physical illnesses, people in our present time also have the same desire...."

"Every night, my experience in the Prophecies" of Hope seminar is great! I feel like I'm attending a Bible study seminar for the first time. I take time taking notes on important points that make the topic more understandable to the audience. I mark down the good illustrations that emphasized the doctrines presented. I, at times, imagine myself presenting the topics in front and making the appeals to the audience. Looking at the reactions of the non-Adventist audience, I'm inspired seeing them agreeing with the message and some praising God with a smile after knowing the precious truth.

While here in PAFCOE especially during the training seminar, Christian has been learning a lot. "I learned to love the work of the Lord more than before and this led me to feel the need of being diligent in doing His work. Night after night, I am happy that I can put into action what I've been learning like mingling with the people who are attending, and helping them to accept Jesus. Also, I found the importance of getting things in order throughout the program. Above all, God is teaching me to empty myself, to be teachable and to be humble always."

Along with the Seminar the enemy marshaled his forces against the forces of light. Hours before the 1st night, PAFCOE's director was rushed to the Hospital for he got a 2nd to 3rd degree burn and was seriously injured. We also faced a lot of challenges with the venue and the noise around us. Yes at times, in the work the enemy might seem to gain the victory but the interests continued on until we transitioned to the recipient Church, Sampaloc. The Spirit of the Lord is at work! The seminar will continue until March 26. Pray for us as we continue to open before the people the riches of redemption found in Jesus.

"Very challenging yet filled with blessings," as Jaiza would love to say it. "Each night with Lemon group was a survival! In the past meetings, I often shed tears because of worries for certain children and I could see myself feeble. Despite of this, I praise the Lord because now they listen and participate in the program. I praise Him for with His help, I am learning from the experiences with the precious lambs He entrusted to me."

Counting the Children's program like that of gardening, Paulo shared his exceptional experiences with Raspberry group, "I experienced discouragement, stress, impatience and intemperance toward the children. I came to realize that unless my heart is first renewed and well watered of the love of God, there will be no love and tenderness towards my little flock. They need garden tools the sprinkler of love, the rake of patience and the shovel of faith through Christ. I must receive daily the dew in the morning—the word of God, which refreshes and softens my hardened heart."

"With all these challenges, one of the things that inspire us to endure is that every time we send them home, they would tell us, 'I will miss you teacher. See you tomorrow!' and then hug us tightly. Those moments are priceless—the burdens of the work are all gone."

Assigned in the most populated group—Blueberry, Rowena and Dafodile recounted, "Previous weeks, we had a hard time keeping the children in order, they're not listening and were fighting. But as the nightly meetings went by, we see changes. Instead of running and escaping from us when we send them home, now they don't. They're the ones who will tell us, 'Where's the paper my mother needs to sign?' And instead of singing secular songs along the way, they prefer to sing Bible verses. We're so happy for the changes. They learned good manners and are now easy to manage. They also responded to the cards we are giving them."

This batch, new things were added in the Child Evangelism training. One of that is the *Nurturing the* Lamb where students pray with the children individually, encourage the children to share what they learned to their family, friends and others, and bring cards showing how their children have been cared for. Also, Child Evangelist trainees are having wonderful time counseling and praying together before having their lunch. They are brought closer together in taking care of the precious lamb.

Before turning to the next page, let's hear from Darlyn, the Child Evangelism teacher. "It's been three years that I am working in the Children's program. Teaching and feeding the lambs with the right kind of food is not easy, but it turned out to be a great blessing to me. Why? because it molds my character a lot. Applying the example of Jesus how He showed His own love and care for the children is my greatest joy. And it is my desire that there will be more of God's people who will not despise the little ones. Oftentimes, children are neglected. We should be reminded, that Jesus has a vision for the children, that great is the value of Child Evangelism. Jesus loves to plant the seeds of truth in the children's heart, knowing that in the future, they would spring up and bear fruits unto eternal life. Today God needs you, like Mordecai, who has a vision for the value of one child."





### **Unto Sharp Sickles in the Harvest-field... Practice Preaching!**

Those who are not just simply memorizing the script for the sake of passing the preaching practice evaluation found satisfaction in Jesus' words and are brought closer to the One whom they are to lift up. Solomon testifies, "I had been truly blessed while studying, and doing the preaching practice. Why? because I was brought into a realization that the message is for me, a rebuke of my weaknesses, of my selfishness and pride, and of my need of a Savior that is preparing an eternal kingdom."

Preaching Practice—the phrase sent chills down the spine of Anjo. "Whenever it's time for preaching practice, I felt nervous. I found it very hard because I had not mastered the script; thus, I didn't know how to speak properly-my fault though. This part of the training was so challenging for me. I felt like I could not do it, but when I read the promises of God and started to claim them, I could hear Him encouraging me to speak and not be afraid. His word assured me that He will always stand by my side. I'm always praying to God that He will give me a spirit of love, earnestness and sincerity to devote my life to Him. I ask Him to teach me always to surrender all and see His goodness. As the training goes on, I need to pray and work, work and pray."





The students had a deep sense of preaching Jesus. Gaspar shared, "To be a preacher of the word of God is not as easy as we commonly think of. It should bear good results for Christ. There is a great importance of our devotion to Him in constant, earnest prayer. We are to do the work in faith for the work can only be accomplished through the power of God- His Spirit dwelling and working in our behalf. We are to do our part by constantly subjecting ourselves in full surrender to Him."

Above all, there should be utter distrust of self and cherishing that love that dwelt in the heart of Jesus. Royco realized, "Unless a person has a genuine love and passion for soul-winning, He will never be successful in seeking the precious souls. Yes we can be energetic for sometime but it will surely wane and eventually we will get tired. It is the love of Jesus in our hearts that will keep us going. We have to be consecrated, devoted and persevering workers. In PAFCOE I have greatly learned to love the work of Jesus."
